Our Doors are Still Open —

Yes, you can still come to the church. We are cleaning and disinfecting the parish regularly.

We ask that you remember the recommended guidelines to keep you and others safe.

1. Maintain social distancing. This means six feet from others.
2. Wash your hands frequently.
3. Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth.
4. Practice respiratory hygiene. This means covering your mouth and nose with your bent elbow or tissue when you cough or sneeze. Then dispose of the used tissue immediately.
5. If you feel unwell, please stay at home.
